


How to create an account on the VHA Train website

VHA TRAIN provides a comprehensive catalog of public health training opportunities and everything on TRAIN is free and open to non-VA staff. The Veterans Health Administration Employee Education System, within the Department of Veterans Affairs supports this and trainings on this platform provide anyone with the opportunity to learn more about Veteran patient care. Community Care providers within the VA Network will need to complete required training courses, an example being, “Opioid Safety Initiative guidelines and Community Care Provider: A Perspective for Veteran Care”, using VHA TRAIN learning management systems.

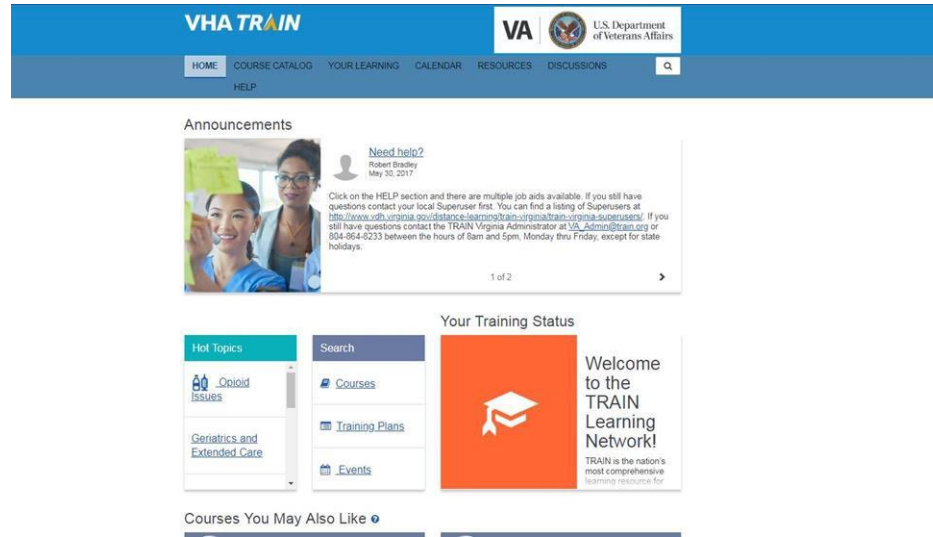

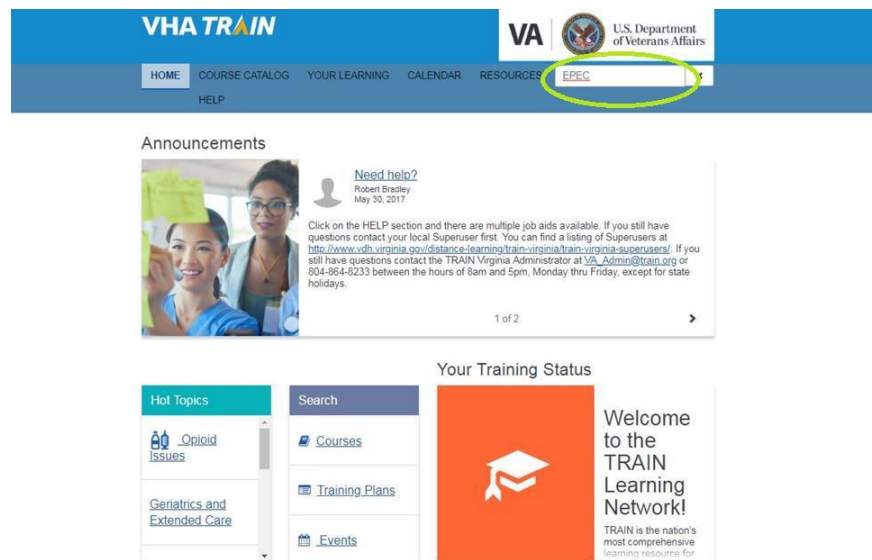


7. Once you complete, it will bring you to the VHA Train homepage
